## **The Hitmaker Cheers White Sox with Remix of Don't Stop Believin'**

**Chicago, October 24, 2005** – **The Hitmaker**, the Chicago-based remix artist, is getting fresh attention for his remix of Journey's "**Don't Stop Believin'**," which has become the unofficial theme song of the Chicago White Sox on their march through the World Series. "We're seeing thousands of downloads a day this week at [www.tierecords.com](http://www.tierecords.com)," says Tie Records International label rep Nicholas Markos.

"It's fantastic," says The Hitmaker. "Not only are the White Sox rocking their way through the World Series, but they've given new life to one of the best rock songs ever, and my remix is a loving tribute."

Revitalizing great rock songs with mesmerizing dance remixes is what The Hitmaker is all about. His mind-boggling remixes of unlikely-yet-perfect dancefloor anthems by **Journey, The Who, Styx, Survivor, REO Speedwagon**, and others, are giving those songs new life, just as the White Sox are giving Journey's original recording new life.

"Songs like **Don't Stop Believin'** have great melodies and magic hooks. My work brings them to light in a new context, where people can enjoy their magic without the usual stigma of, 'You're listening to *Journey?!?!*' It reveals a new side to these songs that's been neglected until now. It also gives me a chance to celebrate and revive some of the music that I grew up listening to on the radio."

Selected The Hitmaker tracks are already being played at clubs around the USA, and the revered Eddy Temple-Morris has also been playing tracks at **XFM Radio** in London. The Hitmaker has performed live with superstar DJs such as **Rjd2**, and is performing live in Chicago at Silvie's (1902 W Irving Park) on October 29. The Hitmaker has also done remix work for other artists, including a track on the recently released *Welcome to Hollywood* (Atenzia) by Glen Burtnik (*Marshall Crenshaw, Styx, Cyndi Lauper*).
